The line-up saw 16 teams fail to field a full side, and this year's format reverting back to the traditional point accumulation throughout the meeting to decide the winners. Top cars were provided by HBDSM, with 72 Billy Bond in a Marina van, 170 Chris Shipp in a Sunny estate, 632 Callum Reed in a Civic and 932 Rhys Reed in a Cherry, while TT179 Jamie Phillips had a Fiesta Chairman invalid car.

JK949 Tony Fideo led the first heat, as a pile up developed down the back straight and into turn 3, with HB72 Bond weighing into AS48 Foppe Minnema. BW195 Luke Wagstaff took over the lead, as HB72 Bond met TP623 Eddie Lane and BD349 Lee Saunders together head-on on turn 4. JK949 Fideo stuffed WB223 Daniel Bear into AS48 Minnema on turn 3, before WB811 Pete Winter blitzed TP623 Lane on the back straight. JK902 Rhys Mills followed into WB223 Bear on the pit bend, Bear collecting SQ345 Karen Lown, as BW195 Wagstaff took the win.

Heat 2 saw a pit bend melee with OD650 Phil Barker fencing OS419 Laura Quadling, helped by EC122 Mark Cooper, before MH390 Dave Gibson fenced EC187 Jack Goodey on the next lap, Goodey then getting blitzed by OD685 Dan Wilkinson. GD112 Darren Prestage weighed into Wilkinson, with OS420 Matthew Jode hitting him. UD313 Scott Elden fired OK316 James Cushion into Prestage, as the pile up grew on turn 4. BD88 Lyndon Stark was shoved into the pile up to suffer a fire, the red flags coming out. The result was declared with UD233 Mark Carter the winner.

UT385 Craig Thurlow was fenced by the pack on turn 4 as heat 3 got underway, with GC273 Kevin McClagish leading. SW403 George Tickner went on opposite to collect SH502 Tyler Bloomfield on the pit bend, as CR730 Brandon Mayes shoved GC273 McClagish wide into the fenced TM145 Colin Dicken on turn 4. McClagish kept going to remain in the lead, as SW757 Tom Farren went on opposite to hit SB410 Jake Calvert. CR730 Mayes

collected the infield blocks into turn 1 to roll, getting clipped by GR123 Kieran Gray as he went over, to bring out the red flags. The result was announced at this point, with GC273 McClagish the victor.

BW9 Tom Jordan headed the fourth heat, as a pile up formed on turn 4, with BR289 Ricky Haresign blitzing BB512 Sean Cooper. The pile up grew as SQ311 Gary Lown went on opposite to hit BW269 Tom Morris. GB312 Brad White took over the lead, as Lown was still on opposite and attacked BW9 Jordan on the home straight. Jordan came under further fire from GB382 Jack Foster Jnr, the latter going on to hit BW269 Morris off turn 4, as GB312 White took the chequered.

EC921 Jack Aldridge led the fifth heat, as the spun AS317 Nick Wakeham was hit by BD135 Jamie Batchlor on the home straight, with BL743 Kevan Barton also crashing in. A pile up then formed at the end of the home straight, with BL743 Barton rolling for a stoppage. On the restart, OS319 Shaun Clarke went on opposite to meet DB294 Lee Hughes in a big head-on. EC837 Martin Wesby led, as OS319 Clarke leant EC921 Aldridge into the fence off turn 4, with OS562 Gavin Barnes weighing into Aldridge, and DB116 Nat Cohn hitting Barnes. DB294 Hughes went on opposite dished out further damage to OS562 Barnes, the latter then having a head-on with DB116 Cohn. OK46 Wayne Packer was stuffed into Cohn by BL551 Brett Jackson, OK538 Curtis Salvage then T-boning Cohn. MT175 Karl Corsby rolled into the fence on turn 1, bringing out the red flags for a premature end to the race, with EC837 Wesby taking the win.

TM430 Andy Jones hooked out BH95 Amber Daniels early in the sixth heat, as CR60 Dan Rea led. SH573 Sam Bloomfield blitzed TT179 Phillips on the home straight, with SB211 Jordan Hall weighing into Bloomfield. The red flags then came out for the fenced BH899 Vix Battle on the back straight, the result being declared with CR60 Rea the winner.

GC723 Jake McClagish was fenced on turn 2 early in heat 7, with ST313 Toby Trenter weighing into him, TW159 Darren Scarrow and GC411 Daniel Pegg crashing in behind. SW388 Taylor Sowter met HB321 Kieron Fry head-on off turn 4, the red flags coming out to check on Fry, but not before SW883 Jack Filmer had weighed into TW159 Scarrow on turn 4 and caught alight. The restart was soon halted with TW26 Dan Holmes rolling on the back straight. BB303 Wayne Linsdell led the next restart, as HB170 Shipp blitzed BW281 Lewis Tingle on turn 1. GD110 Garrie Mirza collected GC664 Ryan Sutcliffe on the home straight, as GB374 Chris Collins T-boned HB170 Shipp and BB303 Linsdell took the flag.

TP623 Lane spun on turn 4 to get taken down the home straight by the pack as the eighth heat started, with JK902 Mills and JK949 Fideo running into the turn 2 fence. BR361 Chris Walden was then spun into the infield blocks into turn 3 for a stoppage. AS212 Jack Maryon led the restart, as TP704 James Street went on opposite to hit BD88 Stark, Stark then going on opposite to take out BR395 Dave Goldsmith. AS511 Jack Licquorice went on opposite to T-bone BL551 Jackson on turn 4, BL121 Aaron Colbert also going on opposite to weigh into AS511 Licquorice. AS212 Maryon went out, the lead being taken over by DB898 Andy Battle and he went on to take the chequered.

EC837 Wesby headed heat 9 from the off as TM10 Ben Collins fenced EC161 Billy Smith on the road bend, with the red flags coming out for Smith. TM142 Jack Lower led a quiet restart and was never headed for the win.

Heat 10 saw UT688 Steve Collings lead as a melee formed on turn 1. DR63 Shane Bullen was blitzed on the back straight by SW884 Tom Filmer, as SB211 Hall met SW388 Sowter head-on on the pit bend. SW884 Filmer blitzed ST317 Callum Jacobs, before TH590 Darren Smith fenced DR297 Paul Chapman on the pit bend. SW884 Sowter was collected by TH585 Kevin Giles down the home straight, before CR119 Davey Cox also hit Filmer. The red flags then came out with AS511 Licquorice alight, the result standing with UT688 Collings the victor.

The points were then added up from the heats, the top eight teams qualifying for the Final being Mad Hatters on 44, Team Grey and Black on 34, Seaside and Crunchers both on 31, Team United on 28, Underdogs on 27 and Team Motorbitz and Twisted Metal both on 25.

The first Accumulator started with 297 Aston Leathers hitting 316 Cushion, before 48 Minnema dished out a huge T-bone to the spun 170 Shipp on turn 4, taking him hard into the armco. 3 Toby Bond weighed into Minnema before the race was halted to check on Shipp. The restart saw 72 Bond take a hammering in the pack, being shunted from the pit bend down the home straight, with 547 Tony McNeil blitzing 632 Reed in the resultant melee, the race again being cautioned with a loose wheel on the track. 116 Cohn led the restart, as 78 Lee Macey went on opposite to attack 9 Jordan. A small pile up developed on the home straight with 113 Dan Wright blitzing 898 Battle, before 135 Batchelor went on opposite to weigh into 78 Macey. 116 Cohn shoved through the growing blockage to stay in the lead, with 811 Winter blitzing 405 Shane Tilley in the pile up, before 116 Cohn did likewise to Winter. The red flags came out with the track blocked, and the result being declared as a dead heat between 116 Cohn and 811 Winter.

Accumulator 2 was soon halted following a big turn 1 pile up. On the restart, 410 Calvert collected the abandoned 650 Barker on turn 4, with 902 Mills blitzing Calvert. Another pile up formed on the home straight in the closing stages, with 110 Mirza hitting 317 Wakeham, 400 Lee Kingsnorth then weighing into Mirza and 122 Cooper hitting Kingsnorth, as 95 Anton Martin took the flag.

The Final saw the biggest grid of the day, with all eight teams gridding all their cars. UD400 Mark Gibbons led them away, before a big tangle in the pack on turn 2 saw MH611 Joe Geeves get airborne and half land on MB313 Craig Osborne, the race being halted. The restart was led by TW37 Dave Lewis, as a turn 2 melee saw a number of cars end in the fence. On the penultimate lap, MB338 Terry Garrod took out TW37 Lewis for the win, but despite team-mate MB328 Dan Lathan taking second place, the Mad Hatters' fourth and fifth were enough to keep them ahead in the points for the overall win with 74 points, while Team Motorbitz were second on 63 and Twisted Metal third with 43.

The DD started with a big pile up on turn 4, a jacking train also forming after 316 Cushion had crashed into the pile up, 307 Martin Kent, 212 Maryon, 313 Osborne, 51 James Licquorice, 113 Wright and 573 Bloomfield all going in. 122 Cooper went on opposite to head-on 110 Mirza off turn 4, as 161 Smith blitzed 632 Reed on the home straight to tip him onto two wheels. 321 Fry weighed into 122 Cooper off turn 4, before 400 Kingsnorth ran hard into Fry. 573 Bloomfield fenced 115 James Martin off turn 4, before coming under fire from 390 Gibson. Gibson and Bloomfield then met head-on, Bloomfield bursting into flames as 400 Kingsnorth hit 390 Gibson. The red flags came out to deal with the fire, and with just two cars left the result was announced as a dead heat between Gibson and Kingsnorth.

The line-up included regular visitors 902 Brad Compton-Sage from the Westcountry and Scot 629 Ewan Millar.

315 Charlie Santry headed heat 1, before 328 Ben Nichols spun on the home straight. The red flags then came out for the stranded 349 Lewis Saunders, with 315 Santry leading the restart. 328 Nichols hooked out 327 Jolie Pettitt off turn 4, before 259 Bradley Eltham spun 303 Jacob Bromley into the turn 2 fence. 629 Millar took out 311 Mike Dobney on turn 2, before 342 Freddie Crittenden and 258 Craig Eltham collected the armco on the same bend, as 315 Santry went on for the flag.

327 Pettitt led the second heat before 315 Santry nipped through on the inside of turn 3. 344 Danny Elbourn collected the home straight fence to get launched into a full roll, bringing out the red flags. The restart saw 327 Pettitt lead, but 308 Molly Smithson soon took over, chased by 315 Santry. The red flags came out again with 259 Eltham in the back straight fence, with 327 Pettitt leading the restart from 308 Smithson and 315 Santry. 902 Compton-Sage shot through to take over the lead, but he was half spun by 356 Harry Overy for the lead on turn 2. However, 902 Compton-Sage fought back to retake the lead, but Overy then spun him on the pit bend. 320 Luke Dorling took over the lead, and went on to take the win, while 356 Overy and 399 Cole Atkins had a close battle in the mid-order.

A much quieter Final saw 327 Pettitt lead before passed by 308 Smithson, and she never put a wheel wrong to go on for victory.
